BOARD OF EDUCATION BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

September 13, 2011 – 6:00 p.m. – School Board Office

1. The GFSS proposal to participate in international travel to Russia with two other schools was approved in principle. Trustees asked the Superintendent to clarify several issues such as District liability, chaperone expenses and eligibility to participate.
2. The auditors from Grant Thornton presented the 2010-2011 Audited Financial Statements. The Board voted to approve the financial statements as presented.
3. The Board has acknowledged that current policies on Electronic Communications in our schools are in conflict with current trends. The Board will move to make changes as quickly as possible. The Board will rely on school-based administration to monitor digital usage.
4. Preliminary enrollment data shows that the District is above projections by 24 students.
5. The Trustees complimented the IT and Maintenance Departments for all the work they accomplished over the summer.
6. The Board has decided to post the most recent “District Operations Trends” information prepared by Adminfo on the District web site.
