

Conflict Detail Screen

(New - Apr 03/06)

This screen is a graphic representation of the student's timetable results (from the simulated schedule), showing course details and identifying schedule conflicts. You can rearrange, drop and add courses and course sections on this screen. Click the **Conflict Detail** button to run the simulation and display the resulting timetable detail on the **Student Timetable Results** screen. If there are timetabling errors and the courses selected cannot be scheduled, an error message will appear.

How is this used by counsellors?

This is a **very** important screen for counsellors. They will use it after a schedule has been finalized for the next year before YET and probably every day in the regular school year.

Counsellors can use this screen to:

- drop courses that cannot be scheduled in an optimum fashion (use the Drop button);
- choose new courses (use either the Period or Course button); and
- make manual changes by typing a new section number.

After making changes, run the timetable simulation again. When you are satisfied with the course schedule, save the timetable.

- 1 From the Student Course Selections screen click the **Conflict Detail** button. The Student Timetable Results (Conflict Detail) screen is displayed. Make changes using the buttons as described below.

The block of buttons at the top of the screen allow you to select or drop courses without having to return to the **Student Course Selections** screen. You can work on this screen until you achieve the desired schedule.

Drop

Brings up the Lookup Course by Period or Lookup Course by Course screen and allows you to select a course to **add** to the student's schedule. The Drop button allows you to drop the selected course from the student's schedule.



There are no Save buttons on the Course, Period or Drop screens. Changes are automatically incorporated in the next Simulation.

The top block of numbers stipulates the course code for the information in the lower grid. The next block of numbers indicates the sections that were scheduled. If there is no section number, then the course has not been scheduled. If you wish to change the course section, you can do it in this screen. Simply click in the Section # under the course code column header and enter the new section # .

The section number can be changed by typing a new number here.

Just below the section numbers are the column headings **Sec** (Section) and **#Enr** (Number enrolled). The column of information on the left is broken out in Semesters and TDP (Term, Day and Period).

Scheduled courses are highlighted in blue in the grid area. Viewing downward from the course code, you can see the section that was scheduled and any other sections available. Viewing horizontally across the grid, you can view conflicts or potential conflicts.

Click the **Course Detail** button to bring up the **Course Details** screen listing course and section numbers, course name, teacher and room, number of students enrolled and potential class size. This is a view-only screen.
